

Louisiana Discovery, Integration and Application (LaDIA) Faculty Fellowship 2019-2020

The LaDIA Faculty Fellowship (www.laseagrant.org/outreach/ladia/fellowships) is designed to build the communication and engagement capacity of Louisiana university researchers. Over the course of three retreats, fellows will participate in science communication training, share their research with stakeholders, interact with state organizations and agencies, receive outreach advice from experts and build multi-disciplinary connections with a coastwide cohort of researchers.

The fellowship consists of three retreats, each at a unique coastal Louisiana location. Retreats are three-days and two-nights in duration. All accommodations, meals, trainings and activity costs are covered by Louisiana Sea Grant. Additionally, fellows that successfully attend and participate in all three retreats will receive a \$250 stipend upon fellowship completion.

Fellowship Requirements (all must be met):

- ✓ Early tenure-track faculty at a Louisiana institution of higher learning
- ✓ Research must be relevant to coastal Louisiana
- ✓ Research must include current or future uses of science communication
- ✓ Attendance is mandatory at all three retreats

Fellowship applications are due April 5 by 5 pm CST and must be submitted via eSeaGrant. All sections must be answered. Upon completion, a confirmation will be sent to your email.

- **Investigator:** Complete info and upload a current two-page CV
- **Overview of Current Research:** description, importance, relevance and efforts at multidisciplinary problem solving
- **Future Research Ambitions:** ideas for research, coastal issues of interest and stakeholders
- **Science Communication:** current and future uses, issues of importance, challenging subjects and past participation in communication opportunities
- **Leadership:** background and organizational activities
- **Retreat Availability:** Identify available dates to attend

1. Follow this URL to eSeaGrant: www.laseagrantedb.org
2. Click on the gray Register tab
