Louisiana Sea Grant College Program invites you to participate in our 22nd ***Ocean Commotion 2019*** at LSU on October 24th. *Ocean Commotion* is a one-day educational event celebrating Louisiana's coastal and marine resources. Especially designed for K-8 students and teachers, *Ocean Commotion* hosts *interactive exhibits* that give students opportunities to learn about and touch the products of the sea and our wetlands – water, animals, plants, and minerals – upon which Louisiana's citizens depend. Since 1998, *Ocean Commotion* has brought together about 65-70 exhibitors, 2,000 registered students and 500 teachers and parents to LSU to interact with exhibits on the sea and our coastal resources.

GOAL: Students will acquire an expanded appreciation for the importance of Louisiana's ocean, coastal and aquatic environments and the need to conserve resources.

WHEN & WHERE: *Ocean Commotion 2019* will be held on **Thursday, October 24, 2019**, from 8:45 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at **LSU's Pete Maravich Assembly Center**.

WHO: Elementary and middle school (**K-8**) students and their teachers and chaperones will be learning from your exhibit.

WHAT: *Ocean Commotion* features exhibits that have *interactive and/or hands-on, minds-on activities* that are appropriate for K-8 students. Electricity is available at limited locations. Exhibitors provide their own extension cords. Lunch is provided. At your exhibit we encourage you to distribute materials suitable for teachers. These may include lesson plans, posters, activities and other materials related to your expertise.
