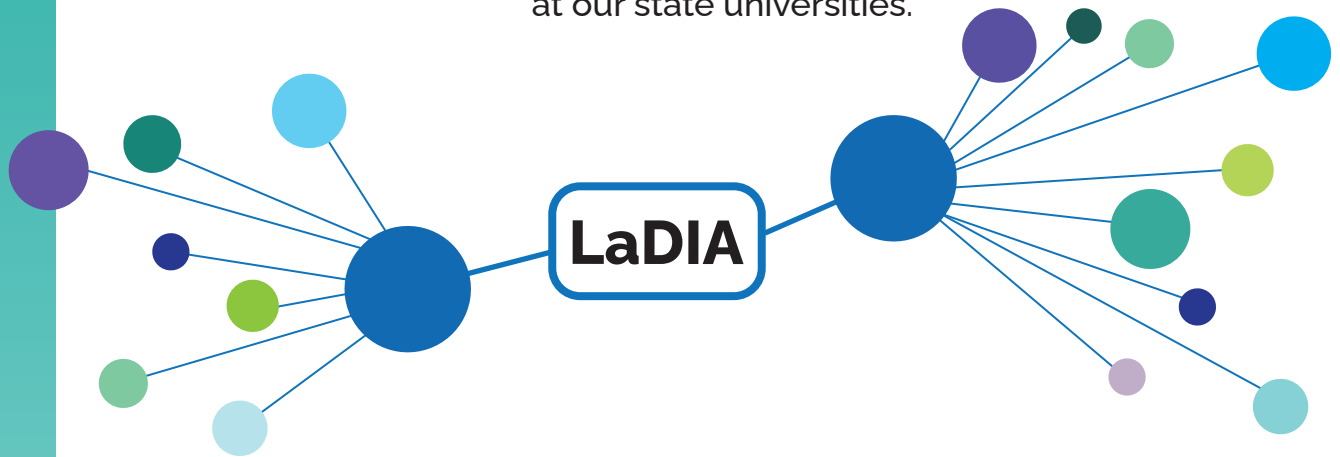


LaDIA Faculty Fellowship
